




The 20-year-old who started as a trainee, but later gets hired

My main goal was to expand my knowledge in the field of cybernetics. Gerildi attended FISA Academy training on cybersecurity, which helped him find a job. FISA training courses enabled him to acquire the necessary knowledge in the field of cybersecurity and also to enhance his skills with advanced techniques. Gerildi learned the first steps towards the occupation, acquired the necessary basics of the Linux operating system for ethical hacking, while Ethical Hacking Fundamental provided him with the basic concepts of ethical hacking and cybersecurity. The RisiAlbania project supported FISA in conducting a study on the demand and supply of the market for cybersecurity workers, increasing the capacities of FISA instructors through training of instructors (ToT), developing new curricula on cybersecurity and organizing a FISA hackathon on this topic.
